**A BILL**

To amend the Commodity Exchange Act to prohibit the listing of contracts relating to war, death, and similar activities.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Discouraging Exploita-  
5       tive Assassination, Tragedy, and Harm Betting in Event  
6       Trading Systems Act” or the “DEATH BETS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON LISTING OF CONTRACTS RELAT-**  
2 **ING TO WAR, DEATH, AND SIMILAR ACTIVI-**  
3 **TIES.**

4 Section 5c of the Commodity Exchange Act (7 U.S.C.  
5 7a-2) is amended by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-  
6 lowing:

7 “(d) PROHIBITION ON LISTING OF CONTRACTS RE-  
8 LATING TO WAR, DEATH, AND SIMILAR ACTIVITIES.—A  
9 registered entity shall not list for trading or accept for  
10 clearing on or through the registered entity any of the fol-  
11 lowing:

12 “(1) An agreement, contract, transaction, or  
13 swap based on an excluded commodity (as defined in  
14 section 1a(19)(iv)) that involves, relates to, or ref-  
15 erences terrorism, assassination, war, or any similar  
16 activity, as determined by the Commission.

17 “(2) An agreement, contract, transaction, or  
18 swap based on an excluded commodity (as defined in  
19 section 1a(19)(iv)) that involves, relates to, or ref-  
20 erences an individual’s death or could otherwise be  
21 construed as correlating closely to an individual’s  
22 death.”.
